

What are BHS Flex Fridays?

Flex Fridays are school days. They are not days off. The Flex Friday dates are chosen intentionally as the Friday after conferences (at mid-quarter) and the Friday before the end of a quarter so that students can have targeted intervention time and enrichment opportunities that take place inside and outside of the school building. If a student has any F's, is missing work, has detention time or is invited in by a teacher, the student is *REQUIRED* to attend on a Flex Friday. If a student does not show up and is required to attend, the absence will be marked as unexcused.

During the 1st quarter we had 284 students in attendance at the mid quarter Flex Friday. We had 272 students in attendance for the end of quarter Flex Friday.

<u>Attendance</u> - If your student is going to be absent from school please notify the school by using our attendance email address <u>bhs.attendance@byron.k12.mn.us</u>. You can also report an absence on the BHS homepage under the Spotlight section.

Infinite Campus Portal - The Infinite Campus portal is your tool to stay connected to your student's education. If you have not taken the time to set up your Parent Portal please contact the office and we can assist you in setting that up. You should be using your own portal, not your students. As parents, you may receive different notifications and messages than your child will. To access Infinite Campus from a computer follow this path:
