New Sign In / Our Process at BHS

Starting November 3rd, students that arrive after 8:00am or leave before 3:00 will have to scan in before entering or leaving the high school. Scanners have been installed in the main office for the students to scan their school ID. Please remember if your student will not be in class physically or virtually the office needs to be notified. Also, hybrid students are required to be in class on your in-person days and on-line during your virtual days.

2020 Giving Back Campaign

Help needed to provide meal to teachers/staff during conference week!

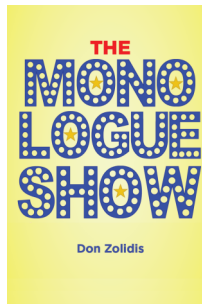

To access Infinite Campus on a tablet or smartphone you will need to download the Infinite Campus app, then enter our District Id, which is **XJLZDW**.
