2020-2021 Student Permission Form - Required

This form is a mandatory form for ALL Byron High School students, including PSEO and Family Flex students. This form must be completed and signed by **both** the student and a parent/guardian. Paper copies of this form along with a self addressed return envelope have been mailed to all families that have not completed this form. A link to this form has also been included below. You can either email the completed form to jennifer.tramp@byron.k12.mn.us or mail the completed paper form to the high school with the self addressed envelope. Another mailing will be sent out soon.

New Sign In / Out Process at BHS - Student ID's Required

All students need to have their Byron high school ID's with them while at school. Scanners have been installed in the main office for students to scan their school ID when arriving after 8:00am or leave before 3:00pm. These ID's are also used to purchase lunch. If you have lost your ID or did not receive one please see Jenni Tramp in the principal's office.

Attendance Reminders

If you are absent, whether in-person or virtual, the attendance secretary must be notified of the absence by a parent/guardian in order for it to be excused. [Report an Absences](#)

- ◆ **Hybrid Students** - You are required to be in class on your in-person days and on-line during your virtual days.
- ◆ **On-Line Students** - Please do the following for each class:
 1. Log in on time
 2. Interact and engage with teacher and class

 4. Stay logged in until dismissed by the teacher
