Transition to In Person Learning - As we transition to the In-Person Learning Model it is very important that you read the [Transition to In-Person Learning Model letter](#) from Principal Schroeder.

In-Person Student Expectations:

- Masks are still required
- In Person Students will be expected to be physically in class Mon. - Thurs.
- The 3ft distance is required in classrooms and locker bays. Classrooms will be set up as spaced out to reflect this requirement.
- In-Person students **are not** able to choose to take "flex learning days". In-Person Learning students are expected to be in class unless the school office is notified by a parent/guardian due to illness, or an appointment.
- Students will report to their Advisory upon arrival to school. At 7:50 a.m. students will report to their first block class.
- All students need to have their Byron High School ID's with them while at school. ID's are used to scan in when arriving after 8:00 a.m. and out when leaving before 3:00 p.m. These ID's are also used to purchase lunch. If you have lost your ID or did not receive one please see Jenni Tramp in the principal's office.

Family Flex Students Expectations:

Expectations remain the same, they include:

- Log in on time
- Interact and engage with teacher and classmates
- Utilize the chat function if needed
- Stay logged in until dismissed by the teacher
